Hometown Light

A fine light American lager that's clean, refreshing and very easy to drink. Only 120 calories, 10 grams of carbohydrates per 12 oz. It offers enough personality and taste to get you where you want to go.

Hometown Pennsylvania Lager

A fine classic American lager that's refreshing and easy to enjoy. A crisp and clean pilsner taste with subtle hops and earthy malts and corn. Very smooth.

Leinenkugel's Sunset Wheat

A soothing Belgian Witbier. Awards Won: Silver medal of the 2006 Great American Beer Festival and Bronze winner of the 2006 & 2007 World Beer Cup in the Herb and Spice Category.

Pilsner Urquell

Today, Pilsner Urquell is an upscale European import that offers consumers a more rewarding and satisfying drinking experience versus other lagers: a full unique taste, a rich golden color and far deeper refreshment.

Peroni

As the taste of Peroni Nastro Azzurro is synonymous with Italian style, so too is the bottle. Claiming the honour of "Birra Superiore", the embossed Peroni bottle has become an international Italian icon.

LECH Premium Beer

Lech Premium's harmonious combination of the right taste and carbonation contributes to the beer's exquisite refreshing properties. It is perfect for the young on the move who do not follow the crowd and appreciate the taste of fun. Lech turns every party into an unforgettable experience.

Troubadour Obscura

Troubadour Obscura is a dark red beer with 8,5 % alc. and refermentation in the bottle. Poured in the special glass, Troubadour Obscura has a nice creamy foam head. The beer has a malty character with a nice little roasty flavour. Troubadour Obscura has a mild bitterness, which is a bit stronger in the aftertaste. Troubadour Obscura has a mainly malty aroma. The smell of roasted, burned wood is completed by a light chocolate touch. Troubadour Obscura is produced with 4 different types of malt, hops, yeast and water.

Troubadour Blond

'Troubadour' is a deep blond beer with 6,5 % alc. and a second fermentation on the bottle. This second fermentation is responsible for the higher alcohol percentage and the further evolution of the beer in the bottle. When poured out in a suitable glass, 'Troubadour' has a thick white tenacious head. The first contact with the tongue results in a lovely sparkling feeling. The flavour is characterized by a mild bitterness and is somewhat spicy, followed by a pleasant sweet aftertaste and dry finish. The aroma is mainly characterized by the spicy hop flavours, accompanied by a light fruity flavour. Troubadour Blond is an authentic beer, consisting of the basic elements: pilsner malt, water, hop and yeast.

Piraat

Piraat is a wickedly rich and rounded brew that packs a mighty punch. The powerful glow builds up from inside. Deep golden with a subtle haze. Lots of hops and malt. Mild sweetness. Reminiscent of bread dough, spices and tropical fruits.

Saint Somewhere Saison Athene

Saison Athene is a bottle conditioned saison brewed with chamomile, fresh rosemary and black pepper. A dose of wild yeast at bottling adds to the complexity.

Saint Somewhere Pays de Soleil

The Aroma Starts with a big funk and bret blast, powdered sugar (sweet tart-ish) notes, mild boozy alcohol, some herbal notes, sharp tart fruits and gooey burnt fruit paste like notes finished off with a little animal musk. Odd, but oddly good. There is just a lot going on in the aroma and that is always nice, but it makes it hard to pull single aromatic sources. The body is a red hued brown and holds a thin but compressed tan head. Bret, funk, veggies, herbal notes, stewed fruits, vinous notes and a sweet fruit finish, but the whole thing is encompassed by the strong bret notes.

Mischeif

The Bruery

Mischief is a Hoppy Belgian-Style Golden Strong Ale. This wickedly good golden ale is fiendishly dry-hopped with American hops to add a layer of complexity and mystery to its fruity, dry Belgian-style character. Citrus and resin diabolically combine with ripe melon, pear and slight peppery spice in a precariously effervescent mixture. Enjoy it, but you'll want to keep an eye out.

Caldera Brewing Hoppportunity Knocks

When hoppportunity knocks, answer it. This ale is Caldera's rendition of answering the Pacific Northwest call for a @*! pile of Centennial hops with a big beer to back it up. Don't get left out in the cold, open up and fill the void within you.

Coronado Mermaids Red Ale

A well-balanced, medium- to full-bodied beer, red in color and very flavorful.

Coronado Idiot IPA

Brewed with 8 different hops and dry hopped with whole cone cascades. Its more powerful than our Islander IPA and even the most intelligent have become "idiot" after a few pints of this super hopped up beer!

Dark Horse Too Cream Stout

Number Too - This beer is made with milk sugar (lactose) which gives this beer a nice creamy mouth feel which mingles with hints of chocolate and roasty flavors.

Dark Horse Perkulator Coffee Doppelbock

This is a true doppelbock and Dark Horse Brewing's only publicly distributed lager. It was so normal that we couldn't stand it so we made it into a coffee doppelbock. Ha, take that Germany, with your Reinheitsgebot purity law! Anyway, we use fair trade organic coffee from our friends at The Ugly Mug Cafe in Ypsilanti, MI We did a label contest and opened it up to the public for this beer. We had so many awesome entries that we couldn't just pick one winner so we have 2 labels for this beer. We stagger the bottles in the six packs but with no order in mind.

Eel River Certified Organic India Pale Ale (America's First Certified Organic Beer) 2009 Silver Medal @ the California State Commercial Craft Brewers Competition

Brewed with the finest organic malts and hops, our IPA features a bright-minted copper color and a crisp, yet smooth hop bitterness. Pale and crystal malts come through with a malty caramel sweetness, balanced with aggressively clean burst of fresh hop flavor in the middle palate without lingering bitter astringency. A strong floral and citrus character from generous dryhopping blends with strawberry esters from our house yeast strain for an inviting and satiating aroma. From grain to glass, our beers are fresh, pure, and organically certified to the highest standards

Eel River Certified Organic Porter (America's First Certified Organic Beer)

No other beer shows off what malts can do in a beer better than porter. Certified Organic Porter uses a complex blend of five malts that compliment and highlight one another in a harmonious mixture. Only one addition of imported Pacific Gem hops is used to provide a balancing bitterness without introducing any other hop character. While decidedly in the robust porter category, Certified Organic Porter has none of the harsh character people often associate with dark ales. Instead, what one finds is a rich, smooth beer with suggestions of chocolate and just a hint of coffee. So smooth and malty, this porter will convert even the non-dark beer drinker..

Furthermore Fatty Boombalatty

The conception and naming of this beer happened in one fell swoop. Unsure whether to offer a light session beer or a fun ball-buster as our warm weather seasonal, we decided on a beer that would be "a big, fatty boombalatty" version of a Belgian white. And away we went, taking a recipe for a white beer and ramping up the grain bill by 50%; we dropped the amount of wheat by 75% to keep the beer rough around the edges. We bucked tradition by steering the bitterness in the direction of a pale ale, and coupling hops with coriander in

the fermenter. The resulting beer gives you all the bubblegum goodness of a big Belgian, with enough crispness to cut through the sweet profile, thus making you want to sip it again and again. Dangerous, indeed!

Furthermore Proper

It's not just about the best beer, but the best places to enjoy it. Nestled in the woods near Spring Green you'll find American Players Theatre. There, the audience can kick back and marvel at the genius of Shakespeare brought to life. APT and its festive, open-air venue have inspired us to craft an elegant, light-bodied and "proper" English Ale. Furthermore Proper is a toast to APT, a Spring Green gem.

Gritty IPA McDuffs 21

Most recent award: a silver medal at the prestigious 2007 Great British Beer Festival for Gritty's cask-conditioned version of the 21 IPA. Gritty's Brew Pubs also have frequently won in statewide polls the titles of "Maine's Best Brew Pub," "Best Maine Microbrew," and "Best Bar."

Just in time for the "big" weather is the "big" bottle of Gritty's new 21 IPA. Gritty's "21 IPA" is a unique blend of American hops with a British body utilizing English 2-Row Pale malts. This IPA starts out with a hoppy aroma and taste; ending with a sweet finish. Plenty of Munich and caramalts are used to give the beer that golden hue. There are fifty-six pounds of Cascade Hops used in each 50 barrel batch that is brewed! Then we finish the beer with Willamette & Warrior Hops, (Warrior is a high-alpha acid variety of hops) All this leads to an IPA that is worthy to celebrate our 21st Anniversary! Gravity: 1069, ABV: 6.8% IBU's: 60.

Gritty McDuffs Lions Pride Brown Ale (Best Brown Ale)

A dark red-amber brew. Smooth, full-bodied, with a subtle finish.

Original Sin Hard Cider

Original Sin was born out of the NYC experience. The founders, all NYC'ers, came to see the need for a superior cider, a cider that was clean and complex with a noticeable bite. The quest to create the perfect recipe encompassed both day and night. Day was spent in upstate in a winery, tasting, testing and mixing. Nights were spent in NYC bars, getting feedback from bar owners and patrons. The result, Original Sin Hard Cider was released to immediate acclaim from sources as diverse as the The New York Times, Paper Magazine, and Market Watch.

Prism Bitto Honey IPA

Bitto Honey IPA was born as a gift to be enjoyed at a going away party for two friends, Don and Maddie Bitto - two new doctors from Philadelphia who were headed to Denver for their first jobs as practicing physicians. Bitto Honey is a twist on the ever popular India Pale Ale and has been brewed with fresh honey and a heavy dose of honey malt to provide great balance to the Amarillo and Cascade hops. We believe that Hops + Honey = Heaven. Don and Maddie agreed and we hope you will too.

Steamworks Ale Diablo

A generous amount of Mt. Hood hops gives the Diablo a sweet cereal aroma that masks its deceptive nature. This sinfully good ale is true to its name.

Steamworks Backside Stout -Winner of a Bronze Medal at the 2009 Australian International Beer Awards

Extremely complex malt and oat flavor; sweet with nice chocolate and roast overtones. The addition of a healthy amount of brewers oats is detectable with a smooth, silky finish. This moderately hopped ale is a great choice for the majority of our dark beer lovers.

A strong blonde ale brewed with six different grains.

Ballast Point Big Eye IPA (2009 American Style IPA Bronze Medal Winner @ LA County fair)

It is brewed with four malts for a deep golden color and to lend a malty counterpoint to the hops. Its full hop flavor is guaranteed to please the palate of the true hop head.

Ballast Point Sea Monster Imperial Stout (Winner of 2 Gold Medals at the World Beer Cup)

Sea Monster Imperial Stout is a new version of an old favorite. This hearty stout is black as the abyss and clocks in at a whopping 10% ABV, a real monster. The flavors of roasted coffee and bittersweet chocolate are complemented by a velvety smoothness from the addition of un-malted barley and oats. Columbus and Amarillo hops help to balance out the huge malt character of this flavor bomb. Be careful the alcohol is well hidden and will sneak up on you if you don't watch out. Like most scary monsters, it can be a little intimidating, but have no fear.

Beer Valley Black Flag Imperial Stout

Created for extreme beer and wine fanatics. Brewed with 8 different malts and massive quantities of Warrior, Chinook, Columbus, and Cascade hops, Black Flag Imperial Stout delivers a beer drinking experience like no other malted beverage on the planet.

Boulder Beer Mojo IPA

Mo-Jo: 1: A magic spell or charm; magical power; 2. Herbaceous ale that summons hop attacks.

Pale in color but packed with flavor, Mojo reflects the perfect balance of hop bitterness and malt character. The unique Amarillo hop adds a slight citrus flavor to an ultra-crisp dry finish.

Boulder Beer Sweaty Betty Blonde (2004 Gold Medal Winner at the World Beer Cup in the Strong Ale Category)

Sweaty Betty Blonde, a Bavarian-Style Wheat Beer, Is Unfiltered and cloudy with subtle hints of clove and banana. Our summer seasonal that you won't want let get away. Best Of the Rockies/Southwest (Wheat Beer)- 2004 US Beer Tasting Championship

BrewDog Punk IPA (2008 honored at National Business Awards for Scotland)

A beer of inherent contradiction. This heavy weight of the beer world is strikingly delicate with a white gold appearance. The light fruity aroma dominates the initial confrontation; lychee, kiwi and passionfruit all prevail with subtle nuances of cherry and strawberry. Don't be fooled however by this smooth medium bodied ale. As it trickles down your throat as this wolf in sheep's clothing begins to grow teeth. The bite comes as the bitterness builds and endures no matter how hard the malty sweetness of the alcohol tries to tame this ferocious beast.

BrewDog Riptide (2007 World Beer Awards Winner for the best Imperial Stout)

It was only a matter of time before the original BrewDog got his paws in on the action. This egotistical young lab has decided to make a beer which best reflects himself. This is the beer equivalent of the big, cute chocolate monster. Soft, smooth, dark, chocolately and very strong. This gentle giant will never bite but would much rather give you a big lick on the face.

Caldera Hibiscus Ginger Beer

Hibiscus flowers and ginger give this unique beer a zesty, spicy flavor. Belgian candi sugar boost the fermentables provided by 2-Row and Carafoam malts. Ginger and hibiscus are boiled with the wort, along with a small amount of Willamette hops. The beer is "dry-flowered" with hibiscus. It was brewed special for the OBF, so get it before it's gone.

Caldera IPA (2009 Gold Medal winner at the European Beer Star Awards)

An American-style India Pale Ale brewed with plenty of body and an assertive hop profile.

Grist: Premium Two Row, Munich, Crystal

Hops: Crystal, Galena, Centennial

Caldera Ashland Amber Ale

A crisp, refreshing amber. Simplicity is the key to this recipe.

Grist: Premium Two Row, Crystal

Cigar City Jai Alai India Pale Ale

Jai Alai India Pale Ale pays tribute to the original extreme sport. Jai Alai, a game native to the Basque region of Spain, is played on a court called a fronton. Jai Alai players attempt to catch a ball using a curved mitt, whilst the ball travels at speeds of up to 188 miles per hour! Proving they have a sense of humor the Spanish dub this game, with its ball traveling at race car speeds, "the merry game." Tampa was once home to a busy Jai Alai fronton but sadly all that remains of Jai Alai in the Tampa Bay area is this India Pale Ale that we brew in tribute to the merry game. The India Pale Ale style of beer has its roots in the strong ales sent from England to thirsty British troops in India during the 18th century. To survive the journey the beers needed more alcohol and more hops (which act as a natural preservative). This "big" brewing practice made India Pale Ale one of the first "extreme beers" and a favorite among the Queens military men in India. Eventually it became a favorite style of the new crop of American brewers seeking more flavor and complexity than mass-market brewers were willing to offer

Cigar City Maduro Oatmeal Brown Ale

A hearty brown ale that benefits from the silky mouthfeel provided by oatmeal, pairs great with Cigars.

Coedo Kyara

Coedo's beer is brewed from selected malts and hops with the technique of beer artisan, braumeister. Rich golden brown with tinges of red - these are the hues of Kyara Beer. The name "Kyara" is derived from the incredibly fragrant Aloeswood tree. The rich, full-bodied flavor of malt is enhanced by the use of highly aromatic hops.

Coedo Shikkoku

Fermented for an extended period of time, this dark brew boasts a stunning contrast between the glossy black tone of the beer and the smoothness of the modest pale head. This glossy black beer is called "Shikkoku," named after the famed elegant jet-black lacquer work of Japan.

Coedo Ruri

Coedo's beer is brewed from selected malts and hops with the technique of beer artisan, braumeister. With the stark contrast of its clear golden hues and fluffy pure white head, this premium pilsener boasts a crisp refreshing taste. The name "Ruri" is Japanese for the gemstone Lapis, representing the pure clarity this beer abounds in.

Fermented with our 150 year old strain of top-fermenting yeast.

Magic Hat #9

A Beer Cloaked in Secrecy An ale whose mysterious and unusual palate will swirl across your tongue and ask more questions than it answers. A beer brewed clandestinely and given a name whose meaning is never revealed. Why #9? Why, indeed. A sort of dry, crisp, fruity, refreshing, not-quite pale ale. #9 is really impossible to describe because there's never been anything else quite like it. Fermented with our 150 year old strain of top-fermenting English yeast

Magic Hat Wacko

This beer truly defies style. A portion of the fermentable sugars that make up this beer come from beet sugar. Real beet extract is used which gives the beer a beautiful light red color. It's body is inviting and the taste is smooth. Hops are barely perceivable and are there to balance out the sweetness from the malt.

Blue Point Toasted Lager 2006 Gold Medal Winner (American Style Amber Lager) Great American Beer Festival

Blue Point Brewing's Toasted Lager is our flagship product. Copper in color this brew is made from Six different malts including: English Pale, Crystal, Munich, Carapils, Wheat and Belgian Caravienna. Toasted Lager displays a balanced flavor of malt and hop which makes it easy drinking. Special lager yeast is used to produce that long lasting, smooth finish. The "toasted" part of the name refers to our direct-fire brew kettle; hot flames imparts a toasted flavor to our most popular microbrew.

Blue Point Summer Ale

Hazy orange copper color. Mild aromas of toffee and nut toast follow through on a round, silky entry to a fruity-yet-dry full body with chocolate-covered raisin, brandy, sugar cane and sour cherry notes. Finishes with a long citrusy, peppery and earthy hop fade. Very nice and polished.
